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NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

The Accreditation Commission voted at a special meeting on March 6, 2018 to suspend DMC Sinai-Grace Hospital's accredited status for continued lack of compliance with the following ACPE Standards: 300.1, 304.3, 306, 308.1, and 308.5.

The center did not file an appeal within the 30-day window that is allowed in *Accreditation Appendix 9: Appeal of Adverse Accreditation Decision(s), Standard 320*. Thus, the suspension initiated by the Commission on March 12, 2018, is now in effect.

To initiate the process for removing the suspension, the center must respond to the notations no later than September 1, 2018. If the center responds by this date, the Commission shall review the materials and take further action at its November 2018 meeting, either by lifting the suspension if all expectations and requirements have been met or by withdrawing accredited status. The center will be informed of the Commission's action no later than December 1, 2018.

Alternatively, DMC Sinai-Grace may respond sooner than September 1, 2018. If the center chooses this option, the Commission will convene a special meeting to review the documentation and materials within 30 days of the receipt of the submission in the national office to determine if the center has returned to compliance with the ACPE Standards.

Failure to respond by September 1, 2018, however, will result in the immediate termination of the center's accredited member status as of November 15, 2018, with notification to the public and to the US Department of Education.

The center is allowed to complete units that are currently in progress. The center may not begin new units or admit new students to its program until final action of the Accreditation Commission is made public.
