History of CPE

1925

– Four theological students came to Worcester State Hospital for clinical training with Anton Boisen.

1930



– The pastoral care and education movement was officially incorporated on January 21, 1930, in the home of Samuel Eliot, pastor of the Unitarian Church of Boston. The newly formed organization is called the Council for Clinical Training of Theological Students.

1949

— The Lutheran Advisory Council on Pastoral Care emerges with the purpose of promoting clinical training as part of theological education, helping seminaries develop training centers, and establishing standards for clinical training programs.

1944




 A group of theological educators and chaplains in the Boston area incorporated as the Institute of Pastoral Care. Helen Flanders Dunbar is named Executive Director.

The Institute had close ties with the seminaries in the environs of Boston and nearby areas of New England.

1957

- The Southern Baptist Association of Clinical Pastoral Education was formed to provide certification for primarily Southern Baptist chaplains.

1967



- After several years of joint discussions and planning, the four groups merged into the Association for Clinical Pastoral Education, Inc. at a meeting in Kansas City, MO.

1969



 ACPE is recognized by the United States Department of Education as the first accreditor of CPE programs.



1980's

– ACPE begins to explicitly recognize the diversity within our movement in the founding of the Racial Ethnic Minority (REM) Network and LGBT Network. This helps to pave the way for more women and individuals from diverse faith / spiritual traditions and other racial/ethnic groups to pursue CPE as professional spiritual care training.

 ACPE has over 400 program sites with reciprocity agreements in 4 countries. Over 2 million hours of Clinical Pastoral Education are provided at these programs annually.
