



FAQs – Accreditation Pause

- Q1: My program has a Year 6 Review scheduled for after June 1st and would prefer an in-person review. Can the Accreditation Commission accommodate this request?
- A1: Programs currently scheduled for a review in **June only** will have the option to proceed with an in-person visit as planned. With the exception of Called Reviews, the Commission will be unable to accommodate in-person visits after June. Programs that do not wish to have a virtual review may opt to postpone their visit.
- Q2: If my program chooses to postpone our Year 6 Review, when will the visit be rescheduled?
- A2: We will not begin scheduling reviews for 2026 and beyond until after the ACPE Task Force has completed its work and has provided final recommendations for process and practice revisions.
- Q3: I would like to postpone my program's Year 6 Review, but I am concerned about my program's accreditation lapsing. What should I do?
- A3: Should you decide to postpone the review, upon your request, the Accreditation Commission will issue a letter documenting the continued accredited status of your program.
- Q4: My program is scheduled for a review later this year and has made the decision to either postpone or continue with a virtual visit in 2025. To whom should I communicate this decision?
- Q4: Please send an email to your assigned Commissioner, the National Site Team Chair (NSTC) for your review, and the Chair of Accreditation.
- Q5: My program is Provisionally Accredited and is due for a review to become a Fully Accredited Member. Can this visit be postponed?
- A5: No. Reviews for programs to move from Provisional to Fully Accredited do not have the option to postpone the review. These reviews will take place virtually.
- Q6: My program is currently scheduled for its Year 6 Review in 2026? When will I be able to schedule this review?



- A6: We will not begin scheduling reviews for 2026 and beyond until after the ACPE Task Force has completed its work and has provided final recommendations for process and practice revisions.
- Q7: My program is hoping to add Certified Educator CPE to our accreditation this year. Will this review request be honored?
- A7: Yes, the Accreditation Commission will continue to accept and review requests for adding Certified Educator CPE as outlined in the Accreditation Manual:
